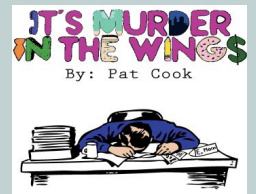


New News

THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS AND POETRY FOUNDATION

The National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation have partnered with the Indiana Arts Commission to support 2016 Poetry Out Loud , a free program which encourages the nation's youth to learn about poetry through memorization and recitation. This exciting program helps high school students master public speaking skills, build self-confidence, learn about their literary heritage, and compete for college scholarship funding. Schools must register before November 30, 2015
